Description: This course provides instruction to the student in basic fire fighting skills necessary to function as a responding member of a fire department. The following topics will be covered in this program:

Building Construction, Fire Behavior, Fire Extinguisher, Fire Hose & Streams, Forcible Entry, Ladders, Personal Safety Equipment, Ropes & Knots, Safety, SCBA, Search & Rescue, Vehicle Fires, Ventilation, Water Supply, and Wildland Fires.

- 7. Firefighter 1 National Certification Testing

When pre-registering for this course, students will be placed in the entire course sections, unless it is clearly indicated that they are not taking part in certain modules. All students will take the Firefighter 1 National Certification Exam and Practical Skills. This course requires published textbooks. **These textbooks will be provided to you at class on the first night.**
